- ADMISSION** - Entry to the venue will be from 12.00noon Saturday via the second gate which is located towards the end of the property boundary heading towards the Kilcoy Township. There is no charge so please bring your family and friends along and support the club canteen and raffle. No parking of any vehicles outside front gate on the road, this is a ruling by council which must be enforced.
- PIT AREA** Please note that parking in the numbered pit sites is strictly forbidden unless you are the owner of that pit site. If you are unsure of your correct location, please ask before setting up. Please note that it is a requirement for enclosed footwear to be worn at all times in the pit area.
- CAMPING** - Camping on Friday and Saturday night is permitted. Hot Showers are available. Please keep the facilities clean. Anyone found vandalising any of the clubs property will be penalised. As there is no charge for camping, we request that all campers assist on Saturday afternoon with small jobs such as track watering, moving rubbish bins etc. The more helpers we have, the quicker these jobs will be done.
 - All generators and music must be turned off by 10:00pm. Children under 16 must be at their own camp by 8:30pm.
 - Please keep noise to a minimum for the quiet enjoyment of all campers.
 - Small fires within enclosed "fire pits" are permitted however must be monitored by a responsible adult at all times.
- SIGN ON** - Competitors will be required to present their Competition Licence & Logbook (in the case of Juniors), to the sign on personnel. Please make sure your endorsement is up to date. Any issues with entries not yet finalised will be done so here by the Race Secretary.
- SCRUTINEERING** – Will occur on Saturday from 5pm – 6pm and from Sunday 6.30am to 7.30am. **Due to large rider numbers we encourage as many people as possible to scrutineer on Saturday where possible.** Will be held in marshalling area at the race entry gates. Machines, helmet, back numbers, body armour (for Juniors) and any spare machines must be presented for scrutineering. BACK NUMBERS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL CLASSES...All bike numbers must be clear and be consistent with MOMS 12.15. For all parent's and support persons, please remember that enclosed footwear must be worn at scrutineering.
- TIMING** – All competitors must have a MYLAPS Transponder connected to their bike for Practice and all Race events. Competitors who have paid to hire a transponder will be required to exchange their Competition Licence for a transponder. Please ensure that if you are riding different bikes that the transponder is changed. Manual Scoring may not occur so points will not be provided if you have a faulty or flat transponder or if you do not swap the transponder between bikes. Hired transponders must be returned at the end of the race day to the timing tent. Provisional Results will be displayed at the timing tent throughout the day which will be located near the track entry point. Should you have any queries on your results during the day, please see the Race Secretary immediately. Please do not wait until the end of day or day after to raise queries.
- TEAR OFFS** – Tear Offs will be permitted to be used. It is a requirement that any tear offs removed in the pit areas are immediately placed in rubbish bins. At the finalisation of race day, it is encouraged that kids walk the track and collect any tear offs. Kids will be rewarded with a small treat such as a Zooper Dooper or Lollipop. Failure to ensure all tear

offs are removed from the track, pits and surrounding areas would be a breach of our Environmental Plan and may mean that the decision to run tear off's in the future would be reversed.

8. **RIDERS BRIEFING** - Will be held near the marshalling area. The first practice group is requested to be sitting on their bikes with helmets removed ready to commence as soon as briefing is completed. All riders and their guardians for juniors must attend Riders Briefing – a random role call may be done.
9. **GUARDIANSHIP FORMS** - If any rider under 18 years of age is attending without their parent or legal guardian they must provide a completed Temporary Guardianship Form to the Race Secretary before entering the track.
10. **SOUND TESTING** - May be carried out. All machines must comply with the current MOM's for noise emissions.
11. **NOISE CURFEW** - No Machine is to be started prior to 8:00am or after 5pm and no PA system can be used before 7:30am – this is a ruling from council and must be strictly adhered to.
12. **CANTEEN** - Will be open from Sunday morning for breakfast until Sunday afternoon.
13. **ALCOHOL & SMOKING** - The carrying of and or consumption of alcoholic beverages by **any** person with the pit or paddock area is strictly prohibited. Smoking is not permitted within 10 metres from the viewing fence or surrounding canteen area. Smoking is also not permitted at scrutineering or riders briefing. Alcohol will be available for sale at the canteen but Liquor licence restricts time at which alcohol is served
14. **MOTORISED MACHINERY/PUSHBIKES** – Pushbikes are permitted to be ridden on Friday until 6.30pm. At all times, persons must be wearing a helmet. Scooters, pit bikes, quads or any other motorised machinery other than competition machines are not permitted at ANY time. Pushbikes are not permitted to be ridden on Saturday by children. Adults are permitted to ride pushbikes to the marshalling area on Saturday provided they are wearing a helmet.
15. **COMPETITION MACHINES** - Competition machinery is not to be ridden at any time outside the boundary of the paddock, pit or track area. A helmet must be worn at all times when riding competition machine and no doubling is permitted. No riding of motorbikes past the competition exit gate up to the canteen area.
16. **CHANGE OF MACHINERY** – Change of machine may be permitted if submitted in writing to the Clerk of Course via the Race Secretary and approved at least ten (10) minutes prior to the start of the event in which the substitution is requested. Substitute machines must be eligible to compete i.e. already be entered for the meeting, have passed machine examination, be eligible for the class and replace a machine that cannot reasonably be repaired
17. **BIKE WASH** - A bike wash bay is located near track entrance. It is preferable that bikes be washed in bay but may be washed in pit area but please be considerate to fellow campers and competitors and their belongings, run off water is not permitted to enter drains or waterways.
18. **50CC DEMONSTRATION CLASS** – If parents are wanting to enter the track you must be wearing hi-vis vests and must have signed the indemnity sheet. Please bring your own HiVis vest along as there is a very limited supply of vests and a high number of riders in this class. Please listen at riders briefing for special instructions as our Demonstration riders do run a shortened track and will commence with a staggered start and no gate drop. Please spread yourselves around the track to help **all** demo riders. Whilst we appreciate the enthusiasm of parents, we request that parent's refrain from yelling, clapping, etc as this can be distracting for the riders and can lead to accidents. Please remember that this is a demonstration class only and not a race class. There are no placings. If your child would like to race, please move them to the 50cc AUTO class once they turn 7.
19. **50CC AUTO CLASS** – Please ensure all bikes comply with the required MOM's for this class. Please fully review and understand what modifications are and aren't allowed in this class.
